An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

When citing a paraphrase or summary from an eBook, the citation should include the author last name and date of publication. When quoting an eBook without page numbers, your in-text citation needs to include the author's last name, year, and the most direct location of the quote, such as a chapter or section title and the paragraph number. Citing an essay is similar to citing a chapter in a book or a story in an anthology. Include the name of the individual author or the group of authors, the title of the essay (placed in quotation marks), the title of the book, collection, or site the essay is found on (in italics), the name of the editor (if there is one), the volume and issue number (if they are available), the publication date, and the location.
