A significant number of acheiropieta originated in the Early Byzantine period, before the advent of iconoclasm in the early eighth century. The most famous acheiropieta included the Mandylion, a white cloth imprinted with the face of Christ, and the Keramion, a ceramic tile which received the impression of Christ's face from the Mandylion.
