General Scoring Notes 1. Answers should be presented in sentences cogent enough for the meaning of the response to come through. Spelling and grammatical mistakes do not reduce the score of a response, but spelling must be close enough that the reader is convinced of the word.

AP PSYCHOLOGY Scoring Guidelines

Responses should include three essential elements: reference to the study's independent variable, reference to the study's dependent variable, and connection with causal language.

What is the average AP® Psychology score? The average score changes with every exam because of fluctuations in students taking the exam and question difficulty. In recent years, the average scores were 3.09 in 2014, 3.12 in 2015, 3.07 in 2016, 3.06 in 2017 and 3.14 in 2018.
